Directions to camp: 120 km from Cape Town



Take the N1 from Cape Town and travel through the Du Toits Kloof tunnel.
 Turn right at the Rawsonville turnoff, after the tunnel.
 You'll find yourself travelling through farmlands until turning right at the Rawsonville turnoff where Goudini Spa is seen on the left.
 When you reach Rawsonville, turn right into Van Riebeeck Street.
 Continue (10 kms) until you reach Nekkies Holiday Resort.
 Turn left here, to Worcester – over a bridge. The Breede River runs beneath you.
 Before Worcester, take the Villiersdorp (R43) turn-off to the right; continue (12 km) down this road, crossing a large bridge over the Breede River.
 At the 1st break in this bridge barrier, as you go over the bridge, turn left.
 Follow the road until you reach – The River Rafters base camp.
